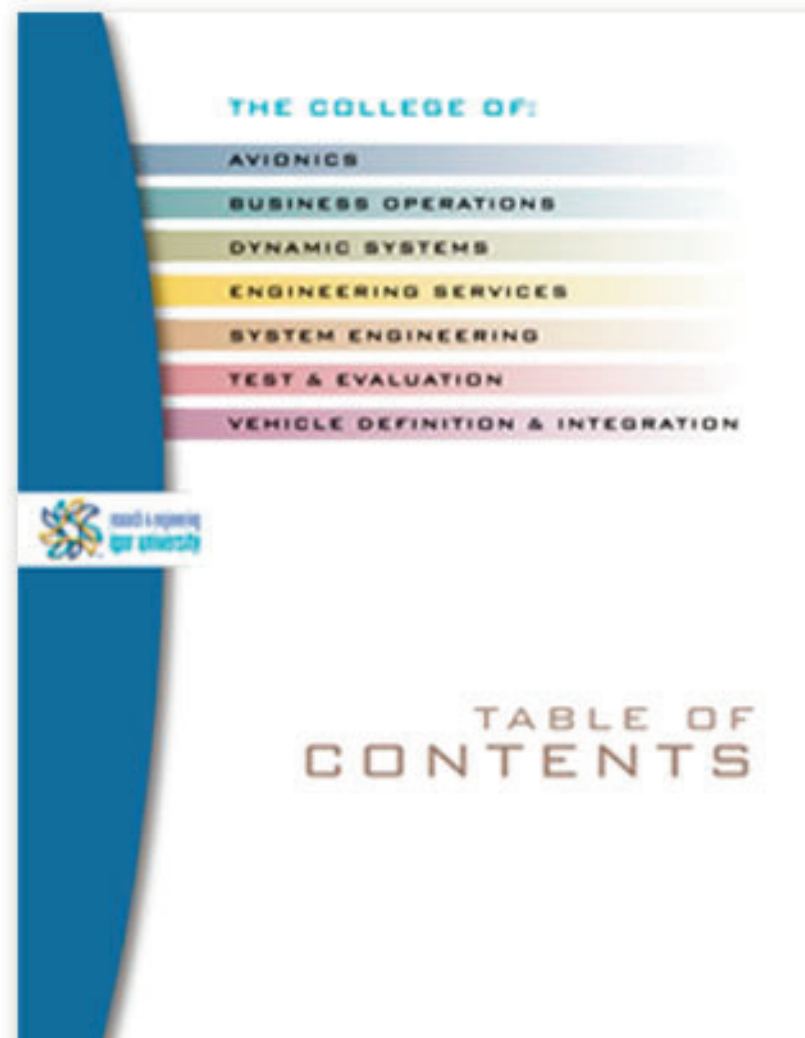
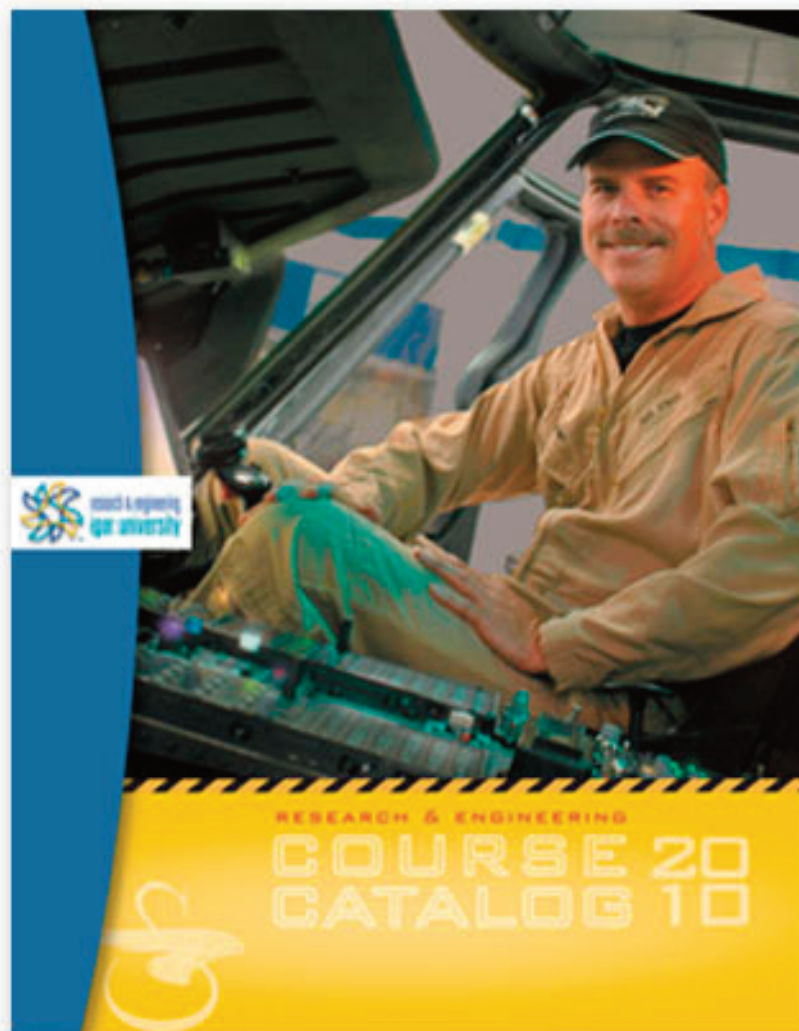
Knowledge Sharing
